("Verint") working with Kova Corp, is please to submit our response to the City of Boston request for proposal titled "Acquiring Technology and Services of Social Media Threats for the Boston Police Department". Our proposed solution will be delivered and supported in its entirety by Verint Technology Inc. Kova Corp. has acted only as a strategic advisor to this proposal effort.

Verint Technology Inc. (a Delaware corporation) was organized in January of 1999 with Federal Tax ID #54-1924753, represents that we remain in good standing in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and has all necessary licenses, permits, approvals and authorizations necessary in order to perform all of the obligations in connection with this RFP and potential Final Agreement.
